WHEREAS, this matter is before the Court on Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Approval of Supplemental Distribution; and:

WHEREAS, Plaintiffs and Defendants have agreed to the entry of this Order (the "Order"); and

WHEREAS, all terms with initial capitalization used in this Order shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Settlement Agreement, unless otherwise defined herein; and

WHEREAS, the Court has considered Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Approval of Supplemental Distribution and the accompanying documents submitted by Plaintiffs in connection with Plaintiffs' Motion, for good cause shown, and having considered the lack of opposition to the Motion; the Court hereby **ORDERS** that the Motion is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The Settlement Administrator, Verita is authorized to issue settlement payments totaling \$25,691.93 to the 33 newly identified Settlement Class Members;
2. Verita is authorized to conduct a second, *pro rata* distribution of the remaining Net Settlement Fund to those Settlement Class Members who cashed their initial settlement checks, subject to a \$50.00 de minimis threshold;
3. All checks issued in this supplemental distribution shall be valid for one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of issuance;
4. After this 120-day period, the parties shall petition the Court for a further order to disburse any remaining Settlement Funds; and
5. The costs of these supplemental distributions, estimated at \$36,735.00 shall be paid from the Settlement Fund.
